

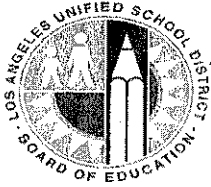

On behalf of Bushnell Way Elementary School, thank you for your time, consideration and support.

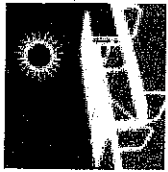

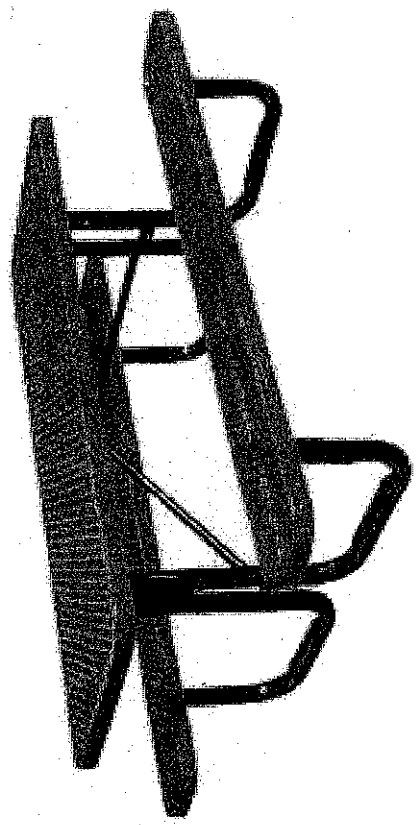
